\* Diagonal line means a food category to which MRL applies is not set.

\* Regarding the MRLs in food categories, "Unshu orange, pulp" and "Peach" are deleted, whereas new ones are established in foods categorized as "Unshu orange (whole commodity)" and "Peach (whole commodity after removal of stems and stones but the residue calculated and expressed on the whole commodity without stems)", respectively, followed by the current food category system for MRLs for agricultural and veterinary chemicals in Japan (These MRLs are to be taken effect on 16 November 2021).

1. "Other citrus fruits" refers to all citrus fruits, except unshu orange, citrus natsudaidai, lemon, orange (including navel orange), grapefruit, lime and spices.

2. "Other spices" refers to all spices, except horseradish, wasabi (Japanese horseradish) rhizomes, garlic, peppers chili, paprika, ginger, lemon peels, orange peels (including navel orange), yuzu (Chinese citron) peels and sesame seeds.
